First Aid Reminders

In an emergency try to remain calm Calmness will help cope with your child If a child is breathing but is unconscious, place on his side in the 'recovery' position. This ensures that the tongue (and any secretions) falls forward and does not obstruct the airway



Ensure the area is safe for your self, others and the patient



RESPONSE

Check for response - ask name - squeeze shoulders

No response

Response

Make comfortable Monitor response



SEND for help

Call triple zero (000) for an ambulance or ask another person to make the call



AIRWAY

Open mouth-if foreign material present Place in recovery position Clear airway with fingers



BREATHING

Check for breathing-look, listen, feel Not normal breathing

Start CPR

Normal breathing Place in recovery position

Monitor breathing



Start CPR-30 chest compressions: 2 breaths

Continue CPR until help arrives or patient recovers









Apply defibrillator if available

and follow voice prompts
